COVID-19 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

As the global effort to stop the spread of COVID-19 continues, The King's Singers are committed to these precautions whenever we're performing, rehearsing, teaching or meeting with others, to preserve everyone's safety.

Our mitigations include, but are not limited to:

- Hand-washing and regular hand-sanitising, for which there is a regular procedure;
- Wearing masks whenever we're not singing;
- Keeping as socially distanced as we can when performing (usually we perform right next to each other, but will maintain a distance of at least 1m at this time);
- Making sure we don't sing directly at each other at close range;
- Regularly disinfecting any equipment we use;
- Not sharing any equipment, music, food or drink;
- Establishing one-way routes throughout the areas we're using;
- Clearly planning staggered arrival times;
- Putting up any signs we need in venues, and using floor tape on the stage as much as possible (following guidance on what's appropriate and/or allowed in a given space);
- Keeping any spaces we're using well-ventilated;
- Establishing safe protocols for using any kitchen or bathroom facilities;
- Asking any crew or management with us to follow these precautions and wear masks throughout;
- Establishing clear and efficient plans for all performing and/or recording time, to minimise the amount of time that we're in closer proximity, and maintain a 1m+ distance at all other times;
- Sharing these internal guidelines with all those we work with, and engaging in an appropriate dialogue with them regarding any additional guidelines they might recommend.
